Talbot Hospice House COVID Visitation Policy

In our continuing effort to balance our responsibility to maintain a COVID-safe environment in the Eleanor A. Koons Hospice House, while ensuring access to your loved one, we are amending our visitor policy <u>effective April 17, 2022</u>:

- VISITORS WHO HAVE A POSITIVE VIRAL TEST FOR COVID-19 OR SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19 SHALL NOT ENTER THE BUILDING.
- Visiting hours: 24-hour visitation availability. All visitors must sign-in at the Hospice House reception desk.
- 3-ply facemasks shall be worn in all Hospice House <u>public areas</u>; meaning anytime when outside of the patient room. Cloth masks and gators are not permitted.
- Only authorized Talbot Hospice staff or volunteers are permitted to open the door for and screen visitors. We respectfully request all visitors refrain from opening the door for unauthorized visitors.
- There are no restrictions on the number of visitors for each patient in the Hospice House at any given time.
- Visitors have full access to all common areas and may help themselves to complementary beverages and snacks located in the main living room.
- Handwashing—including the use of hand sanitizer—remain an important part for keeping everyone healthy. Thank you for adhering to these safe infection prevention practices.
- As patients approach their final days of life, our team will work with the family or primary caregiver (support person), on any additional visit accommodations needed.
